CHAPTER 380.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Harford county to sell and convey to the Trustees of the Masonic Hall and Church in Belair, in Harford county, for the purpose of perfecting the title thereto, a lot or parcel of ground situated in the town of Belair in said county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Harford county be and they are hereby authorized in their discretion, to sell and convey to the Trustees of the Masonic Hall and Church in Belair, in Harford county, all that lot or parcel of ground situate in the town of Belair in said county which is now and for more than twenty-five years past has been in the possession of said trustees, and to determine the true boundaries of said lot by courses and distances, for the purpose of perfecting the title of said trustees thereto.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That said trustees and their successors shall hold said lot in trust for the use of Mt. Ararat Lodge Number Forty-Four, Ancient Free and Accepted Masons, and may regulate the use thereof, and may rent or
