

lease the same and apply the rents, issues and profits thereof, to the repair, preservation and improvement of said property and may mortgage or sell the same and execute a deed in fee to the purchaser thereof, whenever Mt. Ararat Lodge may so determine, and invest the proceeds thereof in such manner as said lodge may direct.

Effective. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

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#### CHAPTER 381.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claim of I. S. Wilson, editor of the Marlboro, Maryland, Gazette, for advertising order of publication in the case of the Washington City and Point Lookout Railroad Company, Robert Callahan, the State of Maryland et al. *vs.* The Southern Maryland Railroad Company.

To pay. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer to pay I. S. Wilson, editor of the Marlboro, Maryland, Gazette, the sum of one hundred and thirty-two dollars, being the amount in full for advertising order of publication in the case of the Washington City and Point Lookout Railroad Company, Robert Callahan, the State of Maryland et al. *vs.* The Southern Maryland Railroad Company.

Effective. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
