Liabie to in-
dictment.

SEC. 47. "Any person violating the provisions of this act shall be liable to indictment by the Grand Jury of the county where the offence is committed, and shall, upon conviction before any Judge of any of the Circuit Courts of this State, be fined a sum not less than fifty dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, for each and every offence, one-half of the fine shall be paid the informer, the other half to the County Commissioners for the use of public roads;" and the same are hereby declared to be in full force in said precinct as in other parts of the State, from the date of the proclamation hereinbefore provided for, declaring the Local Option Law repealed as to said precinct.

SEC. 7. *And be it enacted.* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
