

CHAPTER 400.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the Board of Managers of the Maryland Hospital for the Insane to sell and convey certain land lying between the bed of the Catonsville Short-Line Railroad Company and the Frederick Turnpike, and to purchase in lieu thereof other land more available for the purpose of the Hospital ;

WHEREAS the land belonging to the Board of Managers of the Maryland Hospital for the Insane, lying between the road-bed of the Catonsville Short-Line Railroad Company and the Frederick Turnpike, is by said road-bed divided from the other property and is no longer available for the purpose of the Hospital ; and, whereas the said Board of Managers are desirous of selling said land and purchasing in lieu thereof other land more available for the purposes of the said Hospital.

Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Board of Managers of the Maryland Hospital for the Insane be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to sell and convey by deed to be executed, acknowledged and recorded according to law, in their discretion, the whole or any part of the land belonging to the said corporation lying on the north side of the road-bed of the Catonsville Short-Line Railroad Company and between the said railroad and the Frederick Turnpike road ; and from the proceeds of such sale or sales to purchase and hold for the purpose of said corporation, land lying south and east of the said railroad and adjoining the land of the said Hospital.

To sell and convey.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
