

priations to colleges, academies and schools shall be paid to any of said institutions, excepting to such as shall have made a full report as required by section four of article eighty-four of the Code of Public General Laws; for the Deaf and Dumb Asylum at Frederick, for the education of the deaf and dumb, twenty-five thousand dollars; to Saint Mary's Industrial School, fifteen thousand dollars; to the Female House of Refuge, three thousand dollars; to the Board of Directors of the Maryland Institution for the education of the deaf and dumb and blind colored children of the State, seven thousand dollars; to the Maryland Agricultural College, five dollars and no more; for the instruction of the indigent blind, to be applied under the direction of the Governor, in accordance with the provisions of the act of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, chapter two hundred and five, fifteen thousand dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary; to the Visitors and Governors of Saint John's College, four thousand dollars.
