except when such fees are taxed against and paid by the accused as part of the costs of the case.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 47.

AN ACT to authorize, empower, and direct the County Commissioners of Montgomery county, to refund to Mary V. Harding, only child and heir-at-law of Francis Valdenar, late of said county, deceased, certain sums of money erroneously paid to said Commissioners by the said Francis Valdenar.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of Montgomery county, be and they are hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to refund and pay over to Mary V. Harding, only child and heir-at-law of Francis Valdenar, late of said county, deceased, the sum of one hundred and thirty-five dollars and twenty-nine cents, being money which the said Francis Valdenar paid to the said County Commissioners of Montgomery county, for county taxes on account of the erroneous assessment by said County Commissioners to him, of property in said county that should have been assessed to Joseph F. Burr, for the years eighteen hundred and sixty-nine, eighteen hundred and seventy, eighteen hundred and seventy-one, eighteen hundred and seventy-two, eighteen and seventy-three and eighteen hundred and seventyfour, inclusive.

To refund.
