said amendment to the charter, shall vote, "For the amendment to the charter," and those opposing the same, shall vote, "Against the amendment to the charter;" and if a majority of said voters determine by their ballots in favor of said amendment, it shall immediately thereupon go into full force and effect, and not until then.

## CHAPTER 407.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Annapolis Division Number Ten, of the Order of Sons of Temperance, and to continue in force the act of Assembly of Maryland of eighteen hundred and forty-seven, chapter one hundred and twenty-one for another period of forty years.

Preamble.

Whereas the charter of the Annapolis Division Number Ten, of the Order of the Sons of Temperance, granted by an act of the General Assembly of Maryland, on the thirteenth day of February, eighteen hundred and forty-seven, chapter one hundred and twenty-one, expires by limitation of said act forty years from said date; and,

Whereas the said Annapolis Division Number Ten as aforesaid, desire an extension of its charter and of said act of Assembly as herein provided; therefore,

To extend charter.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the act of Assembly, passed on the thirteenth day of February, in the year eighteen hundred and forty-seven, chapter one hundred and twenty-one, incorporating the Annapolis Division Number Ten, of the Order of Sons of Temperance, and the
