CHAPTER 413.

AN ACT to prohibit the granting of license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer in, at or near the village of Libertytown, in Worcester county.

Unlawful to  
issue license—  
for what.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That hereafter it shall not be lawful for the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Worcester county, to issue license to any person or persons to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer within the village of Libertytown, Worcester county, or at any place in said county within two and one-half miles distance from the Presbyterian Church located in said village.

Effective. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect on and after the first day of May in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-six.
