office on or before the first Monday in June succeeding his election, and a failure to qualify within the time herein specified, shall be deemed a refusal to accept the office; whereupon, the Commissioners shall order a new election to fill the vacancy; and it shall be the duty of the Commissioners to cause to be issued a certificate of election to the person receiving the highest number of votes for Treasurer of said town; and in case of a tie vote for the office of Treasurer, the Commissioners shall order a new election.

SEC. 7. And be it enacted, That the Commissioners shall annually appoint a Clerk, who shall keep the minutes of their proceedings in a well-bound book, which shall be open to the inspection of all persons interested therein, and shall perform such duties as the Commissioners may assign him.

Clerk.

SEC. 8. And be it enacted, That the Commissioners may also annually appoint a Chief Bailiff and such number of under Bailiffs as they may deem necessary.

Appoint Bailiffs.

SEC. 9. And be it enacted, That the Commissioners shall allow their Clerk, Chief Bailiff and under Bailiffs such compensation as they shall think proper.

Compensation.

SEC. 10. And be it enacted, That the Commissioners and all other officers of the corporation shall, before they enter upon the duties of their office, make oath that they will diligently and faithfully, to the best of their skill and judgment, perform the duties of their office, and shall file a certificate thereof, of the officer before whom the same was made, among the records of the corporation.

Make oath.

SEC. 11. And be it enacted, That the Clerk and Chief Bailiff shall give bond to the Commissioners in such penalty and with such sureties as said Commissioners may require, conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties of their respective officers.
