

charter, or by any ordinance of the Commissioners, may be collected by proceedings in the name of the Commissioners before the President of the Commissioners or a Justice of the Peace; and the said President or Justice of the Peace shall have the power to commit the offender to the county Jail on failure to pay such fines or forfeitures, until the same shall be paid with costs.

Fines—How collected.

SEC. 24. *And be it enacted*, That the Commissioners shall not expend, or contract to expend, in any one year more money than the amount receivable from taxes and other sources for that year.

Limit of expenditure.

SEC. 25. *And be it enacted*, That the Commissioners for the county, Justices of the Peace, Sheriff, Constables and all the county and State officers, shall have, hold and exercise their offices and jurisdiction in said town, and the Commissioners of Prince George's county shall appropriate annually the full amount of road tax levied or imposed upon the assessable property within the corporate limits of the town, and shall order the county Collectors who shall collect the taxes within said corporate limits, to pay said road taxes to the Commissioners of said town, for the improvement of the streets and roads within the corporate limits of the town.

County to appropriate.

SEC. 26. *And be it enacted*, That the Commissioners shall have power to establish building lines on all the streets in said town, or which shall hereafter be opened therein, and to compel all persons hereafter erecting building in said town to conform thereto.

Building lines.

SEC. 27. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
