

## CHAPTER 52.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments section forty-three of article sixty-one of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Mechanics' Lien," as repealed and re-enacted by chapter ninety-two of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled an act to repeal section forty-three, article sixty-one of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Mechanics' Lien," and re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section forty-three of article sixty-one of the Code of Public General Laws, as repealed and re-enacted by chapter ninety-two of the act of eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled an act to repeal section forty-three, article sixty-one, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Mechanics' Lien," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

Repealed and re-enacted.

SEC. 43. The provisions of the preceding sections of this article shall not apply to Kent, Charles or St. Mary's counties.
