hundred and five, fifteen thousand dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary.

## CONTINGENT FUNDS.

For the Contingent Fund placed at the disposal of the Governor by article three, section thirty-two, of the Constitution, seven thousand five hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary; for the Contingent Fund of the Treasury Department for advertising, stationery, blank books, expressage, telegrams and other incidental expenses, twenty-five hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary; for the contingent fund of the Comptroller's office, for printing blank licenses. protests, circulars, warrants, books and other office expenses, three thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary; for the Contingent Fund of the Land Office, six hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary; for the Contingent Fund of the Court of Appeals, five hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary; for the Contingent Fund of the Attorney General, for printing and clerical services, stationery, postage and other necessary expenses, to be paid upon vouchers exhibited to the Comptroller, thirteen hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary; for the Contingent Fund of the State Librarian, for porterage, postage, freight, purchase of stationery and other incidental expenses, six hundred and fifty dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary.
