

thousand dollars; for draining, two thousand dollars; for paving basement, one thousand dollars, and for insurance on buildings for three years, two thousand and sixty dollars, or as much thereof for these specified purposes as may be necessary; and the further sum of one thousand and sixty dollars, to re-imburse the Hospital fund for the amount already expended for insurance premiums on the buildings; to the Home of the Friendless of Baltimore city, three thousand dollars; for expenses of the State Board of Health, including the salary of the Secretary of said Board, three thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be paid by the Comptroller upon the presentation of proper vouchers therefor; to the State Vaccine Agent, for his salary, six hundred dollars, and to defray the expenses of procuring reliable vaccine virus, twelve hundred dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary; to the House of the Good Shepherd, five thousand dollars; to the Hospital for the Women of Maryland in Baltimore city, two thousand dollars; and to Saint Mary's Orphan Asylum of Baltimore city, three thousand dollars.
