PUBLIC DEBT.

Interest on
public debt.

For the payment of the interest on the Public Debt of the State, including the cost of exchange, remittance and commissions, for so much thereof as is payable in London, six hundred thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary.

Who to dis-
burse.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the Treasurer of the State shall, on the warrant of the Comptroller, disburse the said sums of money herein appropriated, for the objects and purposes herein specified, to or upon the order of the person or persons, or bodies politic or corporate entitled to receive the same.

When effec-
tive.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect on and after the first day of October, eighteen hundred and eighty-six.
