CHAPTER 427.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Talbot county to appoint an additional Constable in the Fifth Election District in said county.

Additional Constable. Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of Talbot county be and they are hereby authorized to appoint an additional Constable for the Fifth Election District in said county.

CHAPTER 428.

AN ACT to legalize a bequest of Eliza Snyder, late of Washington county, deceased, in her last will, to the Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church of Hagerstown.

Legalizing bequest.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the bequest of Eliza Snyder, late of Washington county, deceased, in her last will to the Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church of Hagerstown be and the same is hereby legalized, and the consent of the General Assembly is hereby given to the said bequest.
