the county without a license so to do, shall be fined not less than ten dollars nor more than twenty-five dollars for each and every offence, and shall stand committed to the county Jail until fine or fines and costs are paid.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That any person, resident or non-resident, found trespassing with dog or gun on any posted or advertised property in said county, or who, upon personal notice to leave, shall refuse to comply, or shall return, shall be liable to be arrested by any Constable of said county upon a warrant sworn out by the owner or occupant of said land, and shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof before any Justice of the Peace of said county, shall be fined not less than five dollars nor more than twenty dollars for each offence, and shall stand committed to the county Jail until fine and costs are paid.

Misdemeanor.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the fines which may under the provisions of any or all of the sections of this act shall be paid by the Justice of the Peace to the County Commissioners of said county.

Fines - disposal of.

SEC. 7. And be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of Talbot county be and they are hereby required to pay a bounty of fifty cents for the scalp of each and every hawk or owl (the fish-hawk excepted) caught or killed in Talbot county, said bounty to be paid in cash by said Commissioners upon presentation of the certificate of any Justice of the Peace of said county that oath had been made before him to the catching or killing of said hawk or owl in said county.

Bounty.

SEC. 8. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
