CHAPTER 444.

AN ACT to define the law prohibiting the sale of spirituous, fermented or intoxicating liquors or alcoholic bitters in Crumpton District, or Election District Number Seven, in Queen Anne's county.

Preamble. WHEREAS the General Assembly of Maryland, at its January session, eighteen hundred and eighty-two, passed an act, viz: chapter three hundred and seven, Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-two, entitled "An act to enable the qualified voters of certain districts of Queen Anne's county to determine by ballot whether spirituous, fermented or intoxicating liquors or alcoholic bitters shall be sold in said county;" and

Preamble. WHEREAS the General Assembly of Maryland, at it January session, eighteen hundred and eighty-two, passed another act, viz: chapter two hundred and forty-four, Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-two, entitled "An act to lay out and establish a new election district in Queen Anne's county, out of portions of the First and Second Election Districts of said county, to be called Crumpton District or District Number Seven, and to submit to the qualified voters of said district the question whether the provisions of the law prohibiting the sale of liquors shall be enforced in said new district; and
