Whereas it was enacted by section eight of chapter two hundred and forty-four, Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-two aforesaid, "That the act passed at this session of the General Assembly, submitting the question whether spirituous or fermented liquors shall be sold in District Number—shall apply to the district herein provided for, and said question shall be submitted to the voters of said new election district under the provisions of said act: and

Whereas the number of the districts mentioned in said chapter three hundred and seven, was inadvertently omitted from section eight in chapter two hundred and forty-four aforesaid; and

Whereas said question as to whether spirituous or fermented liquors shall be sold in Crumpton District or Election District Number Seven, was submitted under the provisions of chapter three hundred and seven, Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-two as aforesaid, to the voters of the said new election district: and

Whereas at the submission of said question under the provision of said chapter three hundred and seven, and at the election held pursuant thereto, two hundred and ninety-three votes were cast in said Crumpton District or Election District Number Seven, "Against the sale of intoxicating liquors" in said districts, and one hundred and fifteen votes, "For the sale of intoxicating liquors" in said district.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That each and all of the provisions of the Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-two, chapter three hundred and seven, are, and shall be operative in and apply to Crumpton District, or Election District Number Seven, in Queen Anne's county.
