CHAPTER 453.

AN ACT to add a section to article sixteen of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Chancery," under sub-title "Process," to immediately precede section one hundred and fifteen of said article, and be numbered one hundred and fourteen A.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the following section be and the same is hereby added to article sixteen of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Chancery," under the sub-title "Process," to immediately precede section one hundred and fifteen of said article, and be numbered 114 A.

New section.

114 A. Where it shall appear that the Court has jurisdiction of a case, but there is doubt as to the residence of a party against whom process is necessary, or the same be wrongfully alleged, several writs may be issued as of course to as many counties within the State, or requisite process concurrently to different places without the State, or both writs and process, within and without the State, for service upon such party ; but if any process hereunder be vexatiously or unnecessarily issued, the Court may order the costs of same to be paid by the party asking or directing the issue of such process.
