CHAPTER 475.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum or money to pay the claim of John Murphy & Company for stationery furnished State Tobacco Warehouses Numbers One and Two.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the Treasurer of the State for the sum of one hundred and forty-six dollars and forty-four cents, in favor of John Murphy & Company for stationery furnished State Tobacco Warehouses Numbers One and Two.

CHAPTER 476.

AN ACT to pay the claims of J. H. Medairy & Company and John K. Carroll.
