

LAWS OF MARYLAND.

CHAPTER 481.

AN ACT to amend section one of an act passed at the January session of the year eighteen hundred and fifty-three, chapter two hundred and three, entitled an act to incorporate the Maryland Institution for the Instruction of the Blind, by changing the name of the said corporation.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section one of an act passed at January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-three, chapter two hundred and three, entitled an act to incorporate the Maryland Institution of the Blind, be and the same is hereby amended by changing the name of said corporation from the Maryland Institution for the Instruction of the Blind to "The Maryland School for the Blind."

CHAPTER 482.

AN ACT to declare the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest of four hundred dollars, contained in the last will and testament of Henrietta C. Long, late of the city of Philadelphia, in the State of Pennsylvania, deceased, to the Vestry of All Hallow's Parish, at Snow Hill, in Worcester county, Maryland.
