Pay.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the pay of each footman shall be not less than two dollars per day, and the pay of the Marshal and four Chiefs of Divisions who shall be mounted and who shall each furnish his own horse, trappings, equipments and forage for said horse, shall be three dollars per day; all pay-rolls to be made out monthly and certified as required by the County Commissioners.

To levy.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the County Commissioners of Baltimore county shall pay annually a sufficient sum, not exceeding twenty-five thousand dollars, upon the taxable property in Baltimore county, to pay said Policemen appointed under this act, and for such other necessary and proper expenses as in their judgment may be required to promote the efficiency, discipline and usefulness of such Police Force.

Effective.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the first day of May next.
