I., No. one hundred and forty-three, folio five hundred and twenty-six, &c., subject to the yearly ground-rent of seven hundred dollars per annum; the reversionary interest in and to said last-mentioned lot and to said yearly ground-rent of seven hundred dollars by said lease, to be purchased or otherwise acquired from said lessors or such person or persons as may hereafter own the same; that fee-simple lot of ground on Sumwalt street, in Baltimore county, which by deed dated the eleventh day of December, and left for record among said last-mentioned records on the twenty-second day of December, eighteen hundred and eighty-five, was granted by Henry Shirk, senior, and wife to said corporation.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
