CHAPTER 499.

AN ACT for the relief of Western Maryland College.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it appears that by an act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, one-half of the number of scholarships, being one for each county and Senatorial District of the State, which had been previously provided for by the State, was directed to and provided for at the Western Maryland College, under the provisions of said act, and that said College has most efficiently and faithfully complied with all the requirements of the law; and

Preamble.

WHEREAS it appears that no provision at the present time exists for the payment of the tuition of said students, the same having expired; therefore,

To pay and how:

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer, on the warrant of the Comptroller, be and is hereby authorized and directed to pay to the order of the Board of Trustees of Western Maryland College the sum of thirteen hundred dollars per annum, in four equal instalments, on the first day of July, the first day of October, the first day of January, and the first day of April, in each year, on and after the first day of July, eighteen hundred and eighty-six, for the payment of tuition as aforesaid; provided, that the appropriation of thirteen hundred dollars herein mentioned, shall
