CHAPTER 65.

AN ACT to repeal chapter forty-five of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled an act to repeal section thirty-six of article ten of the Public General Laws of this State, entitled "Attachments," and to reenact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That chapter forty-five of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled an act to repeal section thirty-six of article ten of the Public General Laws of this State, entitled "Attachments," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Repealed and re-enacted.

SEC. 36. No attachments of the wages or hire of any laborer or employee in the hands of the employer, whether private individuals or bodies corporate, shall affect any salary or wages of the debtor which are not actually due at the date of the attachment; and the sum of one hundred dollars of such wages or hire due to any laborer or employee by any employer or corporation shall always be exempt from attachment by any process whatever.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
