CHAPTER 69.

AN ACT to extend the act of incorporation of the Washington Fire Insurance Company of Baltimore, and the amendment thereto.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the act passed at January session, eighteen hundred and sixtyfive, chapter eighty-two, entitled an act to incorporate the Washington Fire Insurance Company, together with an amendment thereto, passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy, chapter four hundred and forty, entitled an act to amend an act passed January session, eighteen hundred and sixtyfive of the General Assembly of Maryland, chapter eighty-two, entitled an act to incorporate the Washington Fire Insurance Company of Baltimore, and to enlarge the powers of said corporation, be and the same is hereby continued in full force and effect for the further term of twenty years from the expiration thereof, and until the end of the session of the General Assembly next thereafter.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the end of the present session of this General Assembly.

CHAPTER 70.

AN ACT to refund to Adam Thompson, of Allegany county, certain sums of money erroneously paid into the Treasury of the State.
