for a net gain of 150 acres, both in Queen Anne's County; acquired one-half interest in 596 acres in Talbot County by 1766; patented 34 acres in Queen Anne's County, 1771; gave 3,332 acres in Queen Anne's and Kent counties to his son Edward and 326 acres recently purchased in Oueen Anne's County to his daughter Anna, 1774; purchased 150 acres of confiscated British property in Queen Anne's County, 1782; acquired 672 acres in Kent County and 541 acres in Queen Anne' County by 1783; gave 200 acres in Queen Anne's County to his daughter Mary, 1785; had contracted to buy an unspecified amount of land in Queen Anne's County shortly before his death. WEALTH AT DEATH. DIED: on October 9, 1785, in Queen Anne's County. PERSONAL PROPERTY: size of estate unknown. LAND: probably ca. 6,765 acres in Queen Anne's, Dorchester, Caroline, and Kent counties, plus one-half interest in 596 acres in Talbot County and possibly 1 lot in Ogletown.

TILGHMAN, JAMES (1716-1793). BORN: on December 6, 1716, at the "Hermitage," Queen Anne's County; fifth son. NATIVE: third generation. RESIDED: in Talbot County by 1743; Philadelphia by May 1764; Chestertown, Kent County, ca. 1777-death. FAMILY BACKGROUND. FATHER: Richard Tilghman (1672/73-1738/39).
