

1 to what should go into a preamble. Has any action such
2 as that been taken? I wondered if this should go
3 forth or whether the Committee alone was to undertake
4 it.

5 MR. BROOKS: Only partially. We don't have
6 much response on that. I think the Committee should
7 go ahead at this point and we will still be able to come
8 back to it if and when we get response to that.

9 MR. CASE: If that is what the preamble is
10 going to be, I renew with more vigor than before the
11 objection that I had to this whole thing.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: If what is --

13 MR. CASE: If what you are going to do is
14 ask Professors of English and other people around the
15 state to give you some ideas as to what a preamble should
16 be to this Constitution and completely ignore the present
17 Bill of Rights, then I say that the whole thing is
18 just totally and one hundred per cent wrong.

19 THE CHAIRMAN: I don't think there was any
20 suggestion from anybody that that be done.

21 MR. CASE: Isn't that what Mr. Brooks said?
