as that been taken? I wondered if this should go 2 forth or whether the Committee alone was to undertake 3 4 it. Only partially. We don't have MR. BROOKS: 5 much response on that. I think the Committee should 6 go ahead at this point and we will still be able to come 7 back to it if and when we get response to that. 8 MR. CASE: If that is what the preamble is 9 going to be, I renew with more vigor than before the 10 objection that I had to this whole thing. 11 THE CHAIRMAN: If what is --12 MR. CASE: If what you are going to do is 13 ask Professors of English and other people around the 14 state to give you some ideas as to what a preamble should 15 be to this Constitution and completely ignore the present 16 Bill of Rights, then I say that the whole thing is 17 just totally and one hundred per cent wrong. 18 I don't think there was any THE CHAIRMAN: 19 suggestion from anybody that that be done. 20
