proposed by the Committee and secondly for consideration and discussion the articles of the present Declaration of Rights which the Committee recommends be deleted in the notes to the particular section. For instance, we will consider Section 1 as it is drafted and then we will take up the Commission's recommendations that Sections 1, 4, 6, and 7 of the present Declaration of Rights be deleted.
