MRS, BOTHE: Contradictory but that doesn't 1 take away the power or the right. 2 MR. SCANLAN: A natural law right. 3 JUDGE ADKINS: What is the matter now before 4 us for discussion? 5 THE CHAIRMAN: To substitute Article 1 of 6 the existing Declaration of Rights for Section 1 proposed 7 by the Committee. 8 JUDGE ADKINS: May I ask a question? Is the 9 compact theory of government still the generally 10 accepted philosophy of government under which we are 11 operating? It has been pretty well repudiated. 12 What is that? MR. CASE: 13 JUDGE ADKINS: The philosophy that a government 14 is a compact among people. Is that current? I realize 15 it was well ingrained in our political philosophies at the 16 time this document was written. I am querying if it is 17 now the modern concept. I don't know, I am asking 18 Professors on the other side of the room. 19 MR. SCANLAN: What has been substituted in its 20 21 place?
