The other thing is if we are concerned about how to get the most for the dollar, there is no question in my mind that a unicameral legislature could have 50 per cent more staff with at least half of the cost we are presently having now on a bicameral basis.

that at the last full discussion of this question some months ago after the various statements, research papers had been circulated, the Commission decided that the Committee should draft and submit to a convention ultimately drafts providing both a unicameral and a bicameral legislature. Further decided after full discussion by this Commission that this Commission would make a recommendation to the convention on one or the other.

It is to this second part of the question that the Committee has been directing its recent efforts. It is not submitting today the decision of that question to the Commission. It will still be submitted to the Commission at a later date.
