DR. BURDETTE: Yes, I think that again the language perhaps can be improved. I think it was probably written not with any idea that someone is going to start shooting at the governor and Legislature but rather what I really subscribe to and I think/is an immensely modern liberal position that if the people of the State of Maryland want to say that the way our government is being administered is wrong, they have a right to say it. Maybe we need the word peaceable in it but I don't see anything in here which says not peaceable. I think resistance has historically had the view that if we want to get up and say that public housing is not being administered correctly in this state, we can shout it from the roof tops. I like to preserve that kind of meaning which I see in the latter part of Article 6.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Case, in order to save time, might I su gest if this meets with your approval that you amend your motion to refer Section 1 back to the Committee with the direction that the Committee redraft Section 1 to include the substance of Articles 1 and 6
