without any provision for violent overthrow, if that is 1 what your position is, as I understand it. 2 MR. CASE: That is right. 3 THE CHAIRMAN: Would you make that motion? 4 MR. CASE: I so move. 5 MR. SCANLAN: Since I seconded it, might I 6 add, include the substance and as much of the original 7 language as possible. 8 THE CHAIRMAN: Do you accept it? 9 MR. CASE: Yes. 10 MR. GENTRY: Before doing that, may I point 11 out some of this beautiful lenguage in Maryland 12 Constitution is not unique to Maryland. It appears 13 verbatim in other Constitutions and this may have swayed 14 us in our consideration that we were discarding some-15 thing that was traditional. Those words are in the New 16 Hampshire Constitution, for instance, and just in one of 17 our pamphlets just what they said about it, you will 18 recognize this from the New Hampshire, you can recognize 19 it as being in Article 6, same words, "whenever the 20
