2 what your position is, as I understand it.

3 MR. CASE: That is right.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Would you make that motion?

5 MR. CASE: I so move.

6 MR. SCANLAN: Since I seconded it, might I
7 add, include the substance and as much of the original
8 language as possible.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Do you accept it?

10 MR. CASE: Yes.

11 MR. GENTRY: Before doing that, may I point
12 out some of this beautiful language in Maryland
13 Constitution is not unique to Maryland. It appears
14 verbatim in other Constitutions and this may have swayed
15 us in our consideration that we were discarding some-
16 thing that was traditional. Those words are in the New
17 Hampshire Constitution, for instance, and just in one of
18 our pamphlets just what they said about it, you will
19 recognize this from the New Hampshire, you can recognize
20 it as being in Article 6, same words, "whenever the
21 ends of government are perverted, and public liberty
