

1 THE CHAIRMAN: The last two clauses the  
2 Committee has reported on the deletion:

3 MR. CASE: I agree with them on that.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: The motion would be to include  
5 the substance of Articles 1, 4, 6, and the first clause  
6 of 7 without provision for violent overthrow of the  
7 government in either a preamble or new section or sections.

8 MR. SCANLAN: Or combination.

9 MR. CASE: In the language as contained  
10 here?

11 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes.

12 MR. SAYRE: I had not anticipated all this  
13 discussion but I do interpret the fact that we unanimously  
14 adopted the introductory remarks here that this is a  
15 guidance to our procedure, that it is confined to articles  
16 that are judicable or sections. If any of this inclu-  
17 sion should be contrary to this, I think we will have  
18 to suspend or alter the rules accordingly.
