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THE CHAIRMAN: The last two clauses the Committee has reported on the deletion.

MR. CASE: I agree with them on that.

THE CHAIRMAN: The motion would be to include the substance of Articles 1, 4, 6, and the first clause of 7 without provision for violent overthrow of the government in either a preamble or new section or sections

MR. SCANLAN: Or combination.

MR. CASE: In the language as contained here?

THE CHAIRM N: Yes.

MR. SAYRE: I had not anticipated all this discussion but I do interpret the fact that we unanimously adopted the introductory remarks here that this is a guidance to our procedure, that it is confined to articles that are judicable or sections. If any of this inclusion should be contrary to this, I think we will have to suspend or alter the rules accordingly.

THE CHAIRMAN: In the interest of saving time and probably violating all rules of parliamentary procedure, I will rule if this motion carries, it has the
