MRS. BOTHE: Where does the last phrase, Each person remaining responsible for abuse of such rights come from? It doesn't make much sense to me. Article 40 dealing with liberty of the press speaks of abuse of that privilege which I think is somewhat better grammar. for the abuse of such rights. I think it could be better expressed and again this may be a matter for the Committee on Style. I don't disagree with the sentiment. THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Scanian?

MR. SCANLAN: I suppose the

MR. SCANLAN: I suppose the accommodations if a person is to publish something adjudged libelous, then he has abused the privilege and will be held civilly responsible. I suppose that is the original intention, but I agree the grammar could be improved.

MR. CASE: So that the matter can be brought forward, I make the same motion with respect to Section 2 as I made with respect to Section 1, with the necessary institution of section numbers in the Bill of Rights.

Maybe you can press the motion better than this, Mr. Eney,

if you care to do so.
