been circulated. I am sorry you don't have it. I think this particular discussion has brought to mind the fact that it needs to be circulated. You are correct in this view. You have been most helpful in this regard.

We do want next time for you to give some thought along the lines of how your own particular report would be affected by the decision one way or another. Might we move --

MR. SCANLAN: I want to add a factual point

that I don't think is clear. Since the Supreme Court's decision in Baker versus Carr in 1962, the following states have had opportunity to consider whether they wanted to jettison—the bicameral legislature and adopt the unicameral. Michigan, Connecticut, Rhode Island, now most recently the Kentucky Constitutional Revision Assembly, an arm of the Kentucky Legislature,

has submitted very significant proposals to amend the Kentucky constitution but again unicameralism was not adopted. There has been some discussion that this is being considered in all states. The four states that
