

1 THE CHAIRMAN: The question arises on Mr.
2 Case's motion to substitute the substance of Articles 13
3 and 40 of the existing Constitution for Section 2 in the
4 draft proposed by the Committee.

5 MR. BOND: Point of information.

6 MR. CASE: My motion is that this matter be
7 referred to the Committee with directions that the
8 language contained in Sections 13 and 40 be substituted
9 for the language contained in Section 2 where this
10 would be appropriate and would not dilute what they are
11 trying to do.

12 MR. BOND: My point of information is, I
13 think we should be definitive. I like to always agree
14 with Mr. Case, but I can't here. I think the Commission
15 should take the position of whether we should go with
16 the word, government, or word, legislature. I think the
17 Committee should be instructed as to which word would
18 be appropriate under these circumstances.

19 MR. CASE: I might say in answer to that,
20 that I would have no objection to the word, government,
21 if perhaps you put each branch of the Government.
