

1 Article 40 except to change the verb, ought, to, shall.
2 Is that correct?

3 MR. CASE: And if the Commission thinks that
4 the words, every citizen of the State, is too restrictive,
5 I would have no objection to saying, all persons shall be
6 allowed to speak, write and publish.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: I think we will make more
8 progress if we split that into two motions, and make your
9 first motion as to the first sentence.

10 MR. SAYRE: So moved.

11 MR. SCANLAN: I second.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Mrs. Freedlander?

13 MRS. FREEDLANDER: I would like to ask Mr.
14 Case a question with regard to, any branch. Would that
15 include divisions such as the Department of Education
16 which is not a branch or the State Roads Commission
17 which is not a branch, or the State Taxation Assessments,
18 would that be considered a branch?

19 MR. CASE: What I am suggesting here is that,
20 the right to petition the Legislature, would/clearly
21 preserved by this language, but it would be broadened to
