what circumstances the abuse of that privilege is consummated.

DR. JENKINS: We should not limit this to, citizen, because this is simply not a protection to the individual, protection of the people to have a right to know which may come from outside the area of citizens.

MR. MILLER: I am concerned. Doctor. with

MR. MILLER: I am concerned, boctor, with
the situation where we may be confronted with it where
an organized move comes in that isn't based on any
citizenship right, but it might hamper the courts who
say, You can't do this. Now, it is true they might stand
responsible and be deported to Moscow or something, but
I don't see why we should necessarily give everybody a
right to do anything, no matter how irresponsible he is.

DR. JENKINS: That is what we ought to do.

MRS. BOTHE: It is not a question of the individual's right, but a question of what can be done within the State of Maryland, where everybody here has a right of free speech and free assembly whoever they happen to be, foreign dogs and cats, for that matter.
