8 MR. GENTRY: Section 3, which follows, No
9 law shall be enacted respecting the establishment of
10 religion. We want to take them up separately and see if
11 there is any quarrel there.

13 MR. HOFF: Out of curiosity, what does that do
14 with the Vespery Act?

15 PROFESSOR ASPER: This replaces an awful lot
16 of stuff, 37 and 39.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Gentry?

19 you have a religious test, it might be well to read
20 Section 37 of the Constitution. No religious test ought
21 ever to be required as a qualification for office or
