in lieu thereof the following, Every person shall be allowed to speak, write and publish his sentiments on all subjects being responsible for the abuse of that privilege.

You ready for the question? All in favor of the substitution, signify by holding up their hands.

Opposed. Motion carried, 11 to 7. Section 3.

MR. GENTRY: Section 3, which follows, No law shall be enacted respecting the establishment of religion. We want to take them up separately and see if there is any querrel there.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any comment?

MR. HOFF: Out of curiosity, what does that do with the Vespery Act?

PROFESSOR ASPER: This replaces an awful lot of stuff, 37 and 39.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Gentry?

MR. GENTRY: 36, 37, and 39. In 37, where you have a religious test, it might be well to read Section 37 of the Constitution. No religious test ought ever to be required as a qualification for office or
