legislation or veto it, he gains a lot of information as to what he should do to guide him when it finally gets to him if it does. Therefore, I have some personal feeling in favor of the bicameral system.

MR. MARTINEAU: Mr. Chairman, I should like to mention one point that hasn't been discussed up to now. I think it is a consideration that weighs heavily in my mind.

That is that in the Senate as it is now going to be constituted there are certain counties that in effect will have no representation. I think this is going to continue in the future where small counties are going to be joined in senatorial districts with large counties, the smaller counties are going to wind up without any representation.

I think it is a mistake to think of the Senate as being something which protects the smaller jurisdictions in the state. I think it would work just to the contrary. I would like the Committee in considering this to consider the possible evil effects upon certain counties in the state by having actually no
