THE CHAIRMAN: Let's move now to consideration of the third report of the Committee on Legislative Department.

DR. BARD: Mr. Chairman, let's start with III, Page 3, then I think actually the first recommendation/is II will have more meaning if we come back to it. THE CHAIRMAN: Very well.

DR. BARD: The first recommendation is that terms of Recommendation Three deal with length of term of Legislators, that the terms of the members of both the Senate and House should be four years, which is what it is now. However, that the terms of members of both Houses should be staggered so that one half of the members of the House and one half of the members of the Senate would be elected every two years except for the first election.

At the first election after the adoption of the new constitution, one half of the members of both the House and the Senate would be elected for a sixyear term. The other half would be elected for a four-
