2 MRS. FREEDLANDER: Just for the sake of
3 accuracy, she said the act of free exercise is not a free
4 idea. The Federal Constitution prohibits. It is --

5 MR. SCANLAN: Prohibits restraints.

6 MRS. BOTHE: Prohibits Congress from making
7 any law. That should be in the Maryland Constitution,
8 but we should not go beyond it to all the language as to
9 how you worship God or it is okay if you worship God, any
10 God, but please worship one.

11 PROFESSOR ASPER: We don't say anything like
12 that in Section 3.

13 MRS. BOTHE: The corollary to that is the dangers
14 I see in the Section 3 proposed that people should not be
15 restricted in the free exercise.

16 MR. SCANLAN: That is what the Federal Consti-
17 tution says.

18 THE CHAIRMAN: Let Mrs. Bothe finish.

19 MRS. BOTHE: My opinion is to have a very simple
20 provision that the General Assembly shall pass no law,
21 the Government shall enact no laws restricting freedom of
