2           Mr. Chairman, after having heard the discussion,  
3 I would certainly be amenable to an amendment, and I would  
4 like to amend my motion so that the language would be  
5 as follows; attempting as I am to preserve as much of  
6 the venerable language as is possible consistent with the  
7 modern concepts of law in this area.

8           I would suggest two sentences in place of the  
9 clause, which would be as follows: Every man shall have  
10 the right to worship or not to worship in any manner that  
11 he thinks most acceptable. All persons shall be equally  
12 entitled to protection of their religious liberties, semi-  
13 colon, wherefore no person shall by any law be molested in  
14 his person or estate, et cetera, as it goes down to the  
15 end of the language.

18           MR. CASE: Every man shall have the right to  
19 worship or not to worship in any manner that he thinks
