8 to fundamentals suited for today's society.

12 of Section 3, reading, No person shall be restricted in
13 the free exercise of religious profession and worship, and

16 he thinks most acceptable. Every person shall be equally
17 entitled to protection in his religious liberty, semicolon,
18 wherefore no person shall by any law be molested in his
19 person or estate on account of his religious persuasion or
20 profession or for his religious practice.
