Section 3, reading, No person under the color of religion

shall disturb the good order, peace or safety of the

MRS. BOTHE: Point of clarification -- where does this leave us now with this Section?

THE CHAIRMAN: Section 3?

MRS. BOTHE: Yes.

THE CHAIRMAN: The first clause of the second sentence is deleted, and in place of that you have substituted two sentences, Every man shall have the right to worship or not to worship in the manner he thinks most acceptable. Every person shall be equally entitled to protection in his religious liberty wherefore no person shall, by any law, be molested in his person or estate on account of his religious persuasion or profession or because of his religious practice or the lack thereof.
